ALLOWABLE MATERIALS TO BURN

Dry weeds, garden waste, irrigation ditches, trees and shrub trimmings less than 2.5 inches in diameter, and scrap lumber.

Burn Permit Requirements

1. Burning is permitted only during daylight hours, 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and must be extinguished at all other times.
2. An adult must constantly attend the fire.
3. Burning of household waste or trash, or anything other than the allowed materials listed above is NOT permitted.
4. Burning of materials that cause a dense smoke or odor such as tires or plastics is NOT permitted.
5. The following safety precautions shall be followed:
 - a. Have a water hose, fire extinguisher or other appropriate water source available.
 - b. Keep fire a minimum of 15 feet from any exposure, structures, fences, etc.
6. Do not burn when wind could cause the fire to get out of control.
7. If the Fire Department believes that conditions are unsuitable for a controlled burn, it may suspend the burn permit until it determines that conditions are suitable.

PENALTIES

Anyone burning without a burn permit may be issued a citation. The fire will be put out and a complaint will be signed. The individual(s) may be fined and will be liable for fire fighting and/or property damage costs.
